Responsibilities

- Assembles, moves, or distributes items as assigned based on production schedule, customer orders, work orders, or shipping orders
- Responsible for shipping and receiving all raw and finished goods
- Weighs/counts items for distribution to ensure compliance with company standards
- Sorts and stores perishable goods in refrigerated storage
- Labels materials and products in a timely manner per company standards
- Tracks and maintains detailed records of materials and/or items received or distributed
- Assists in managing and maintaining accurate, up-to-date inventory counts and records
- Transfers items from receiving and/or production areas to designated areas
- Manually loads and unloads materials onto or from pallets, trays, racks, and shelves per company standards
- Loads materials onto vehicles and installs strapping, bracing, or padding as needed
- Operates forklifts and other manual and automated operating equipment while maintaining quality standards
- Loads and drives company vehicles with kegs/cases/equipment/other deliverable items
- Executes deliveries up to 5 days per week including non-local stops (Chattanooga, TN)
- Assists on canning line and production processes as needed
- Organizes, cleans, and maintains brewing, packaging, and storage areas, ensuring a spotless workspace and compliance with company quality, sanitation, and safety standards
